- European education and certification program for heat pump installers (EUCERT) in AT, BE, DE, SE, FI, FR, UK, SZ, IT (planned)
 - Common training material for heat pump installers
 - Mutual recognition of qualification in participating countries
 - Certification according to EN 17024
- **Project participation** (QualiCert, SEPEMO, Ground-MED, Ground-Reach, Sherpa etc.)
- **Policy monitoring** and **information dissemination** with stakeholders (MEP)

EHPA <u>quality label</u> for <u>heat pumps</u>

- Based on measurements according to EN 14511 in accredited labs
- Additional requirements: 10 years spare part guarantee, existing service network, installation manual in local language

- Registered in Brussels


