



Participation in expert interviews


>> All four ambassadors participated in extensive interviews about their careers and experiences


Girls Pioneer Event

Target group

→ Female high school students from all over Austria (110 participants)

Goal

Make young women, the future professionals of tomorrow, pioneers in the energy sector and demonstrate in an interactive way what a career in energy has in store for them and what paths are open to them

Up with full energy!-Event

Target group

Women from the energy sector who are already fully in their professional lives and aspire to management positions (86 participants)

Goal

➤ Increase the visibility of female careers from the energy sector to support career opportunities for women in energy and innovation

 Introduction of different women's networks from the energy and technology sector to strengthen the networking of women



Implementation

Panel discussion with leading women (incl. C3E Ambassadors) and men from the energy sector discussing the framework conditions that are necessary to break through the "glass ceiling" for women

Second panel discussion in which representatives of different women's networks presented their activities


Twitter analysis


Conduction of data analysis of communication activities on twitter related to women in energy

 Collection and analysis of 50,000 individual tweets including 80,000 different hashtags

➡ Findings show that

- can be used to promote #womeninenergy to a greater audience





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
