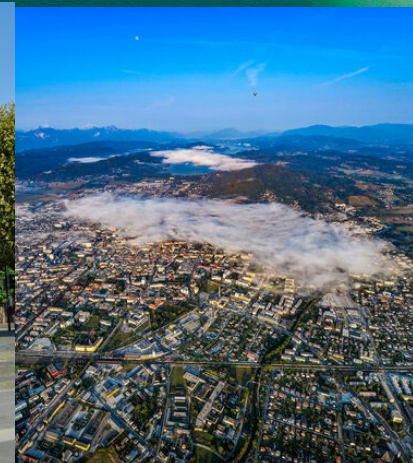


Klagenfurt on Lake Wörthersee



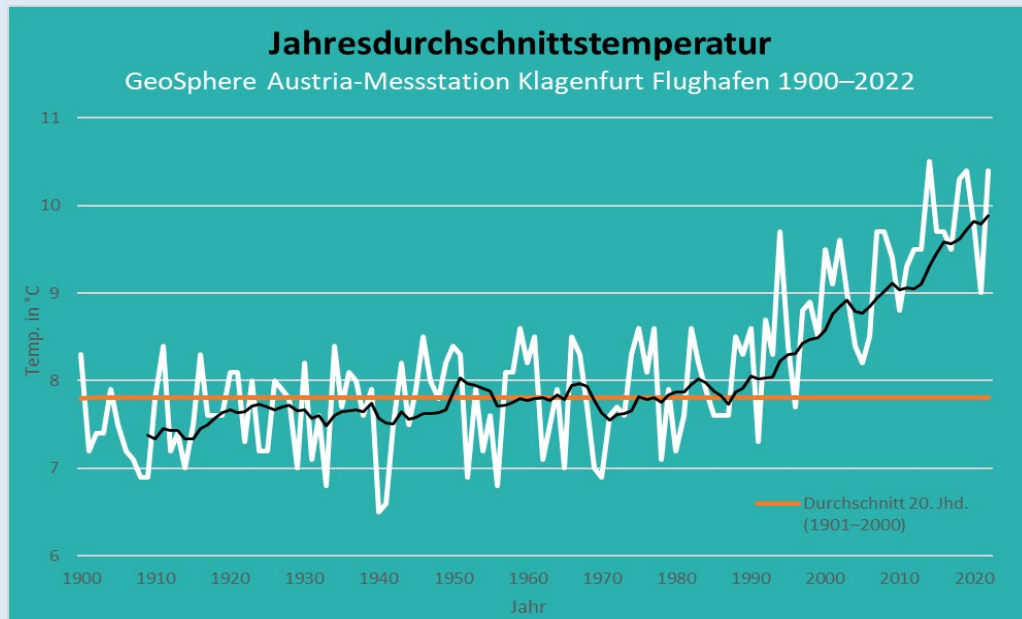
Department of Climate and Environmental Protection

- 120 km²
- Capital of Province of Carinthia
- Trade and school center of the region
- Center quite densely populated
- Forests and agricultural land



Climate Change in Klagenfurt

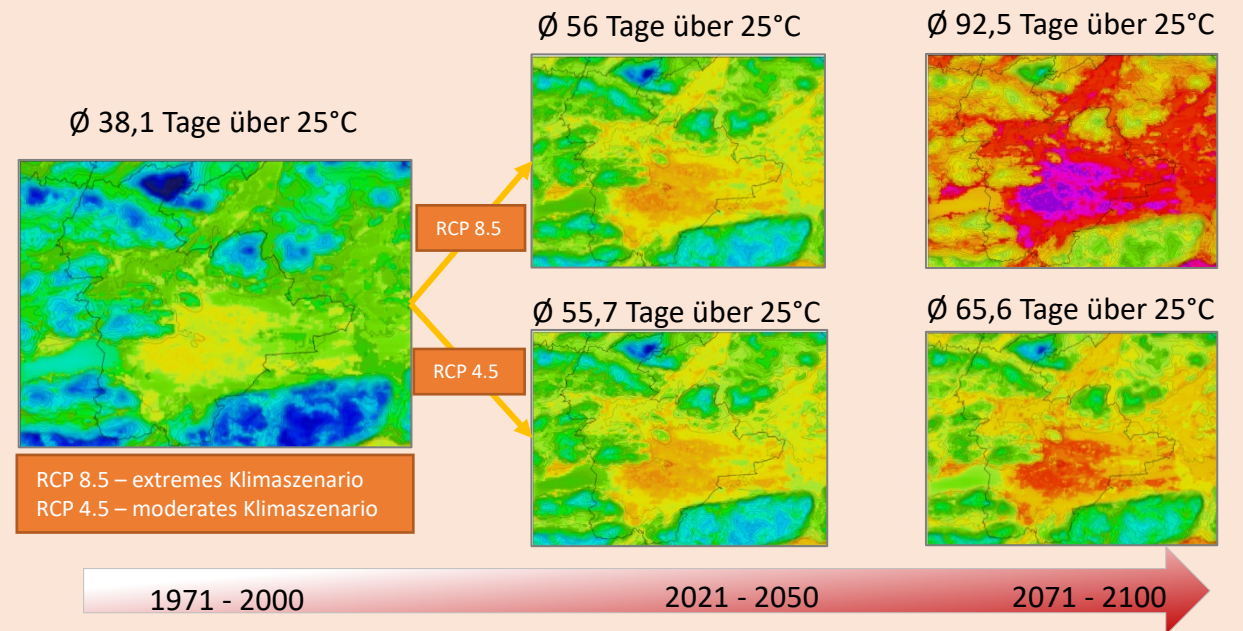
Past



- Average temperatures have increased since around 1980
- Currently approximately 2°C above the average of the last 100 years
- Continuing upward trend
- Cities in the Alpine region are climate change hotspots

Future

- Steady increase in summer days (>+25°C) until 2100
- In 2100, up to 130 summer days in the city center = 1/3 of the year
- For comparison, in 2000, approximately 55 summer days in the city center
- Climatic conditions similar to those currently experienced in Rome, Barcelona, or Istanbul

Vision

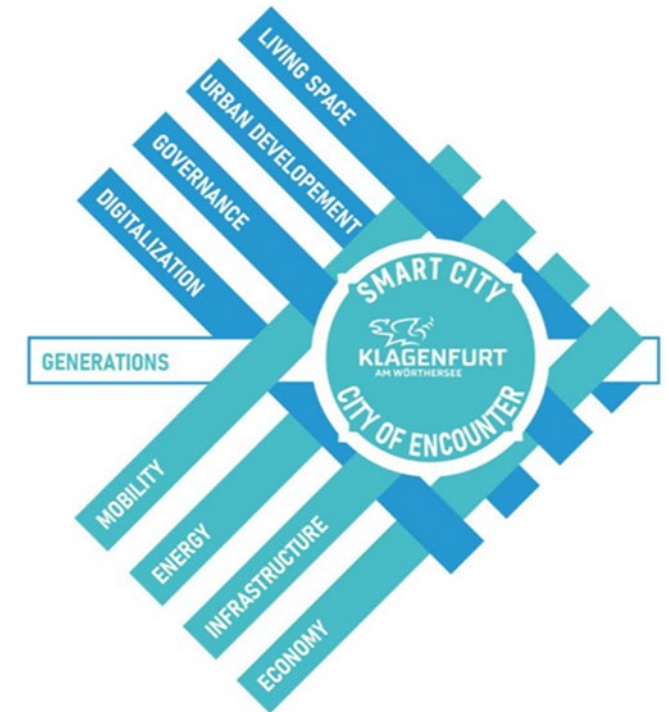

-90% CO₂ by 2040

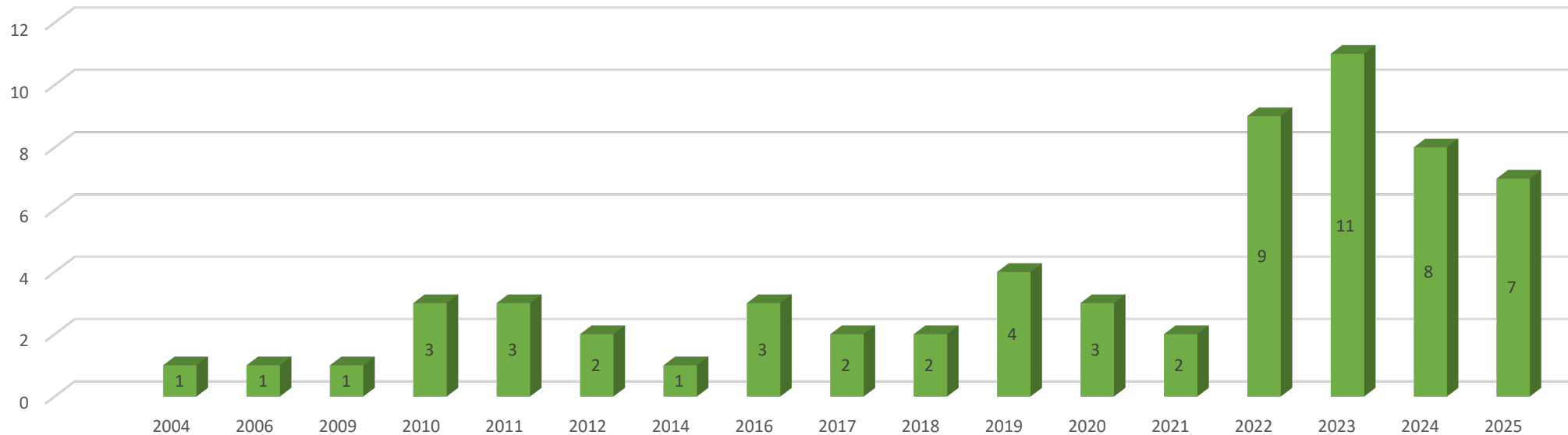

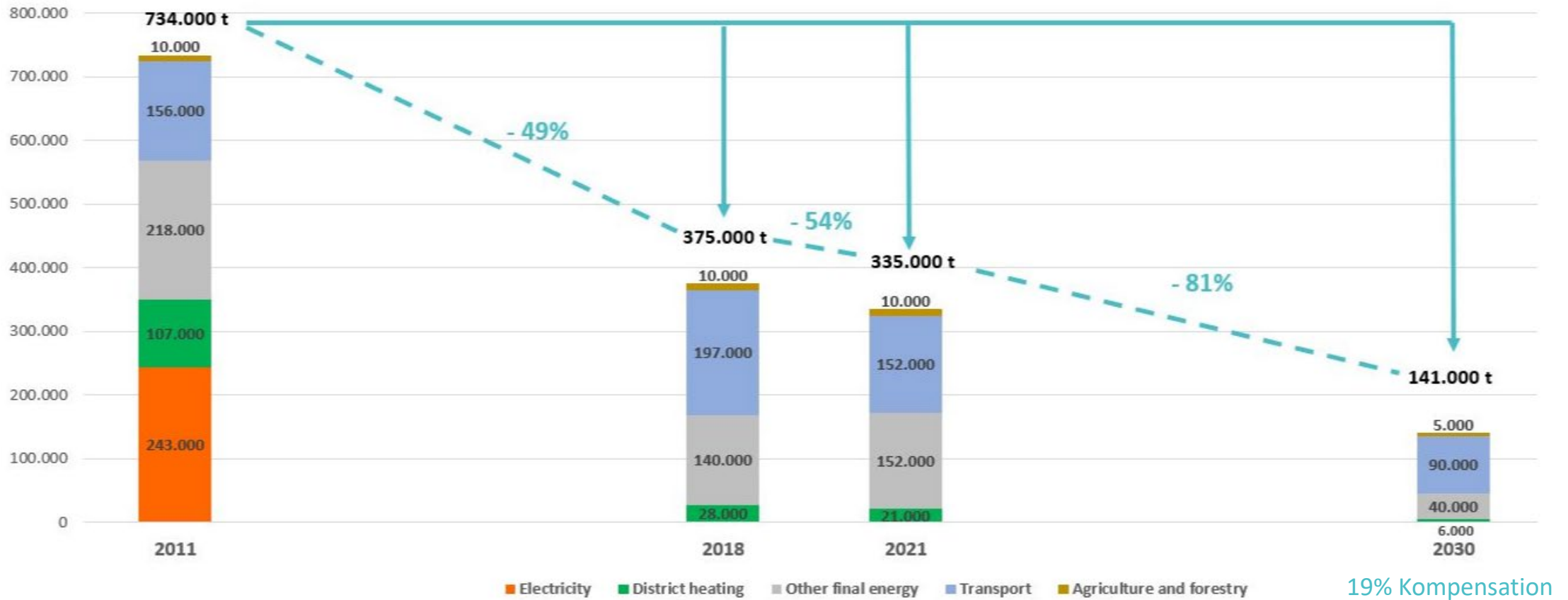

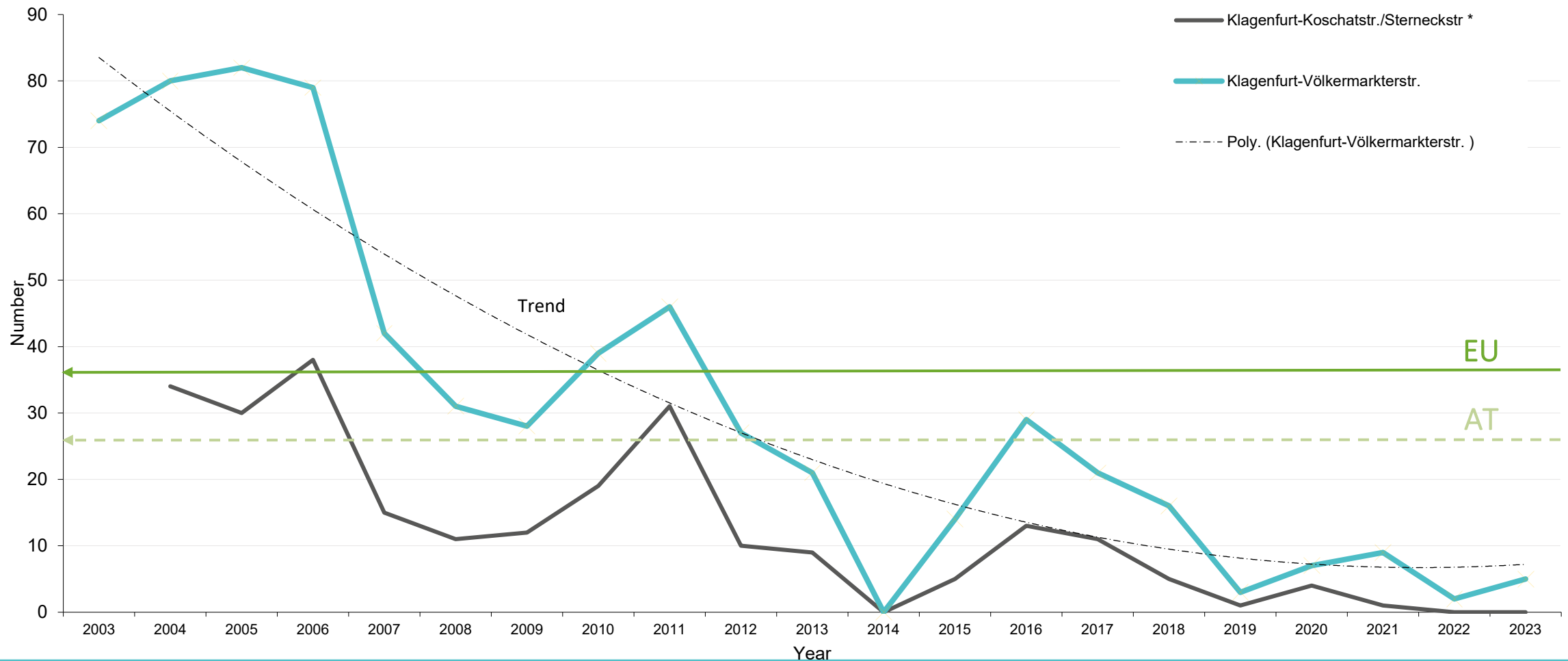


Path to Climate Neutrality by 2030

CO2 emissions and savings 2011 - 2018 - 2021 - 2030 [tCO2]

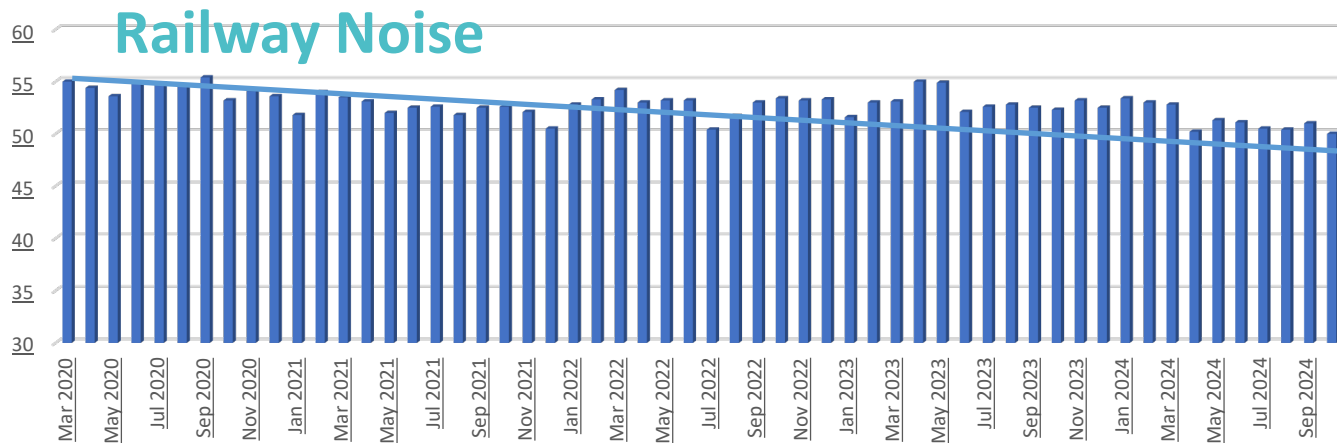
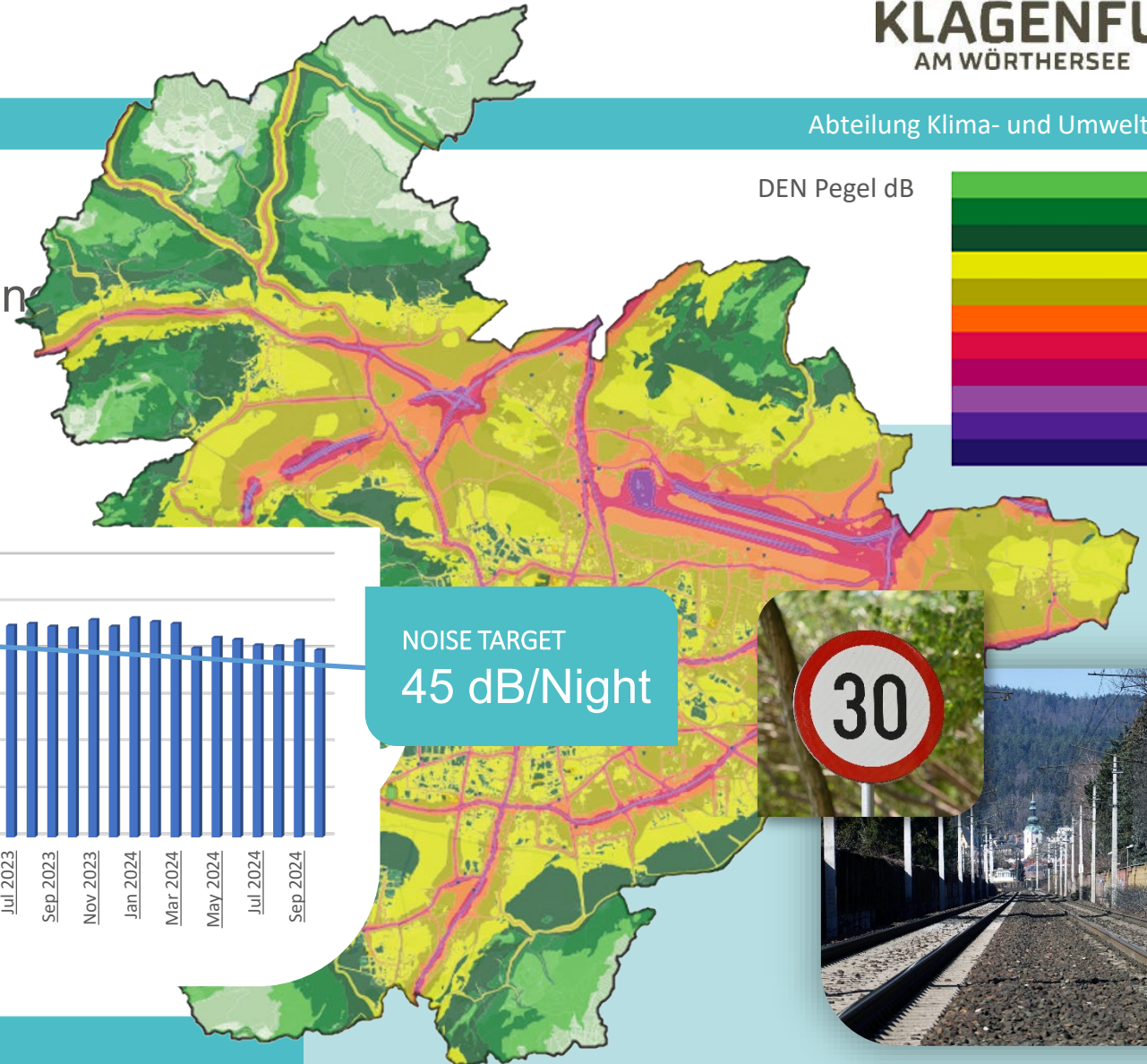


Number of Days with Exceedances of Limit Values Development of Air Quality (PM10)

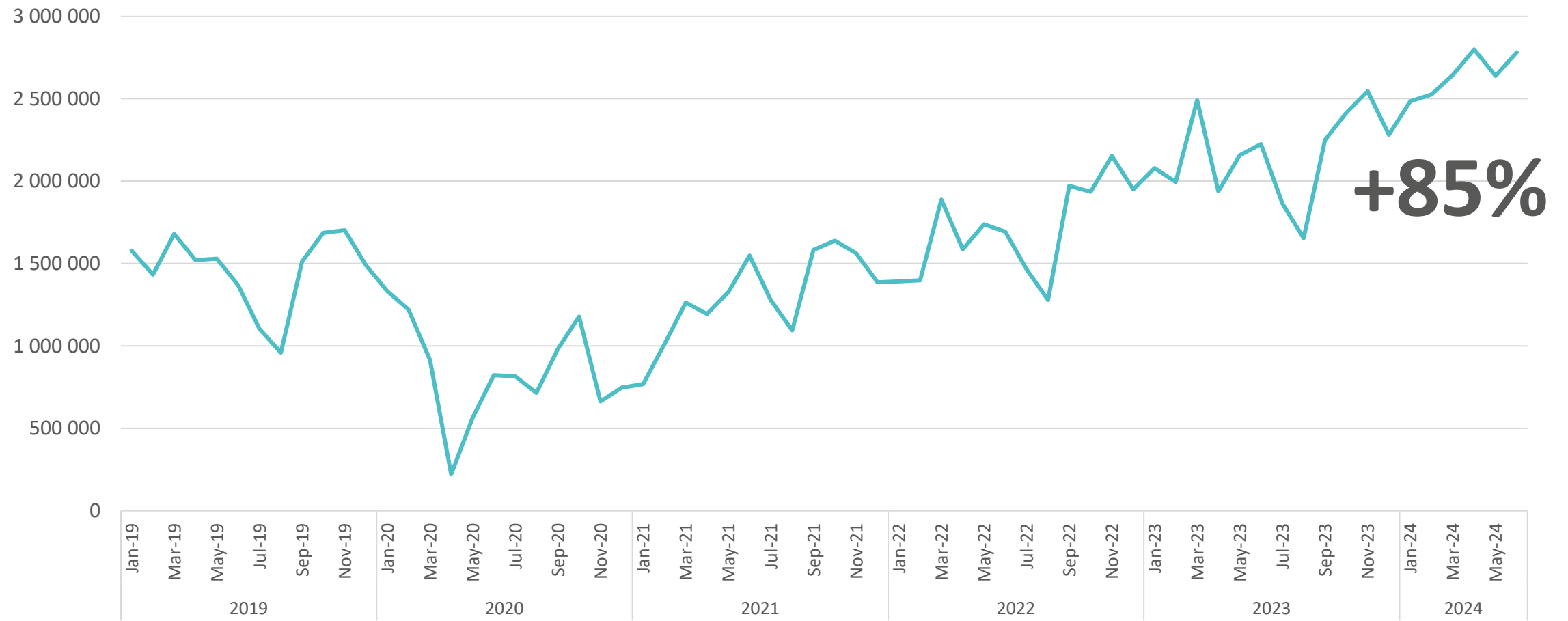

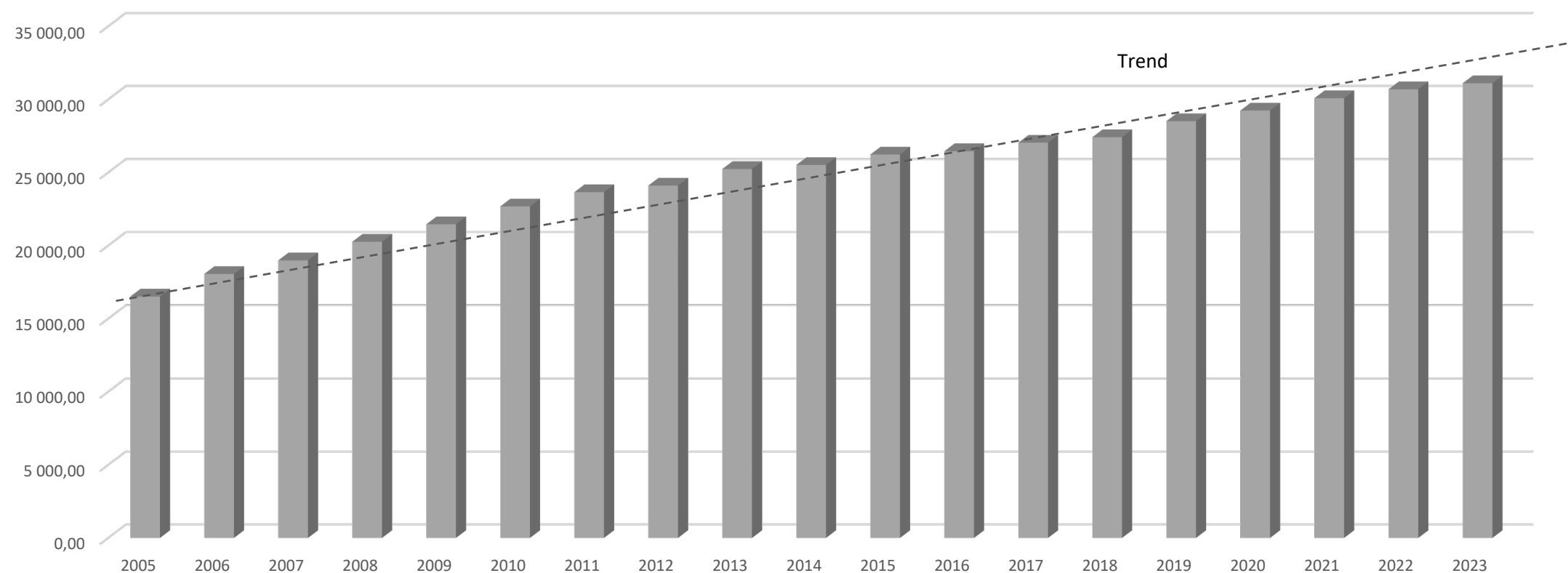

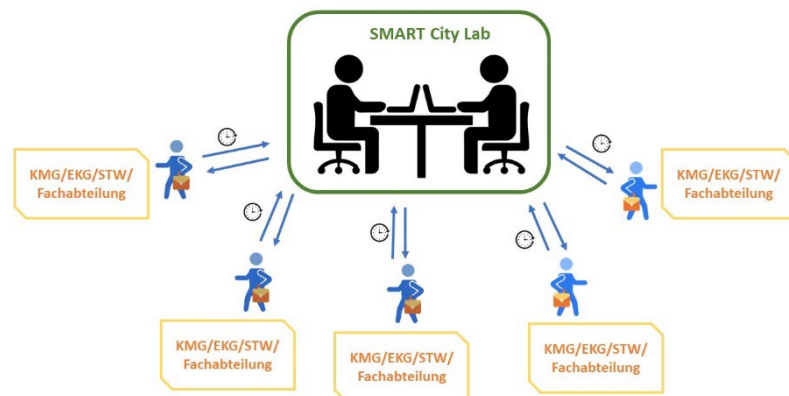
- Opened June 2023
