CONGRESS SCHEDULE

The conference will be held as a four days event (2 days conference, 1 day cooperation exchange, 1 day technical tour), starting on Wednesday 5th October, 2005. The congress structure is based on practically oriented plenary and parallel sessions and poster exhibitions as well as cooperation talks on renewable energy and energy efficiency.

The congress provides a platform for exchange of information and contacts for Central European research institutions, consultants and companies. Participants from the new EU member states and accessing countries are strongly encouraged to come to Vienna. We offer special conference packages for participants from these countries.

PLENARY AND PARALLEL SESSIONS

The conference offers lectures on the EU Building Performance Directive, on Eco-Buildings (built good practice examples) and Eco-Regions (reports from ongoing Concerto Projects). Focus of good practice presentations is on technical excellence as well as on economical feasibility.
